Learning outcome 1

Give basic personal information using spoken language

Assessment procedure

A fluent interlocutor asks the learner four personal questions, including how to spell their surname.

Some suggested questions:

- What's your first name?
- What's your surname?
- Where do you come from?
- Where do you live?
- Are you married or single?
- What's your telephone number?

Assessment conditions

- Learners must be assessed individually.
- The learner must successfully provide correct answers to four simple questions for person information and pronounce key letters and words intelligibly.
- The learner must spell their own name correctly.
- Each question may be heard up to three times.
- The learner may indicate that repetition or clarification is required.
- When assessing, you should adhere to the assessment criteria, conditions of assessment and methods of assessment as detailed in Section C of the course document.
